Olivier Toublan is to be the new chief editor of Bilan, succeeding Alain Jeannet on 1 January 2003. Mr Jeannet is leaving to take charge at L'Hebdo.

Thirty-five years old, Olivier Toublan is a member of Bilan's inner circle and is currently deputy chief editor of the economic monthly of French-speaking Switzerland. He holds a doctorate in economics and a degree in theology, and began his journalistic career with L'Agefi, moving to Bilan three years ago.

A specialist in financial questions, he was involved in the preparation of the French language reference manual on accounting, *Maîtriser l'information comptable*, by Professors Alfred Stettler and Bernard Apothéloz. His doctoral thesis at Lausanne University's business school was on the responsibility of companies to society.

At Bilan he made a major contribution to launching the magazine's new presentation and to its success in the market over the past two years.
